6. Site Matters

Work Parties

- o Deer Fencing

ACTION: GM to talk to a deer expert about best solutions and their costs.

 Hosepipe Proposal - it was agreed that anyone will be able to fill a personal water butt etc by hosepipe from mains supply, at no extra charge, at restricted times, and that anything larger than a water butt would require committee approval.

ACTION: JM and MW will draft the proposal

ACTION: JM to follow up with OCC

ACTION: JM will change the website to say that the scythe is available to borrow, but nothing else.
